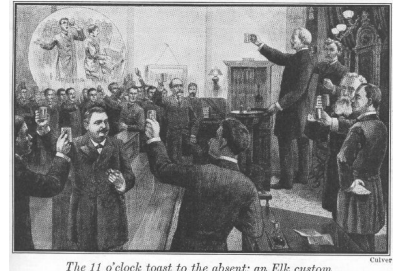

A Message from Bradenton Elks Riders – Lodge #1511 thank you for your generous donation to the Atticus Event. This was an event which spanned over a three month period and we were able with your help to raise \$8,700.00. Words can not expressed how grateful and touched Atticus and his family are and the money was only one part of this for them. They are now part of a bigger community of people who have opened their hearts and fought the battle with them.

Here an update on Atticus and his treatment:

Mid-September, Atticus had a surgery to remove an aggressive tumor/cyst from his brain that was causing a loss of motor function in his left arm and loss of balance. The surgery went very well and they removed 99% of the cyst and the shunt. Atticus initially started bouncing back then another tumor started growing at a fast pace in his brain. They started radiation treatments at the beginning of October and at the end of October another tumor started growing in his shoulder right away. A CAT scan was performed to see if it was in his lungs, and fortunately, that came back negative. It is, however, in his blood.

November 10th was his last radiation treatment for his brain tumor and the following week the radiation treatments for his shoulder completed. The medical team believes they were able to remove the majority of the brain tumor. The UVA team has been in communication with St Jude on the next steps. Atticus has started chemo treatments for his shoulder tumor, which is still slowly growing. An MRI has been requested for the next week to determine if the radiation was successful in removing the brain tumor and determine the size of the shoulder tumor. The one shining piece of news is that Atticus slowly gaining the use of his left arm and beginning to walk again. He has managed to still smile and be a beacon of light.

Words cannot express the gratitude the Jimenez family has for the Elks riders, Elks and all who have contributed to the fundraisers for them. They are absolutely blown away by the compassion from people who live so far away and whom the family may never have the chance to meet. I also am at a loss for words. Thank you for all you have done to help this young man and his family! Elks Care! Elks Share!

Thank you once again for your generosity and the huge difference you have made to Atticus and his family. Let's continue this fight to cure childhood cancer.

Thank you so very much!! I appreciate all you do. Merry Christmas and New Happy Year!!

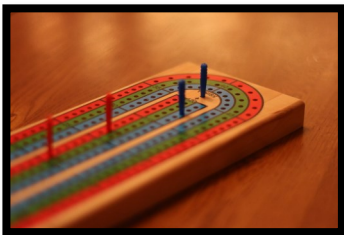

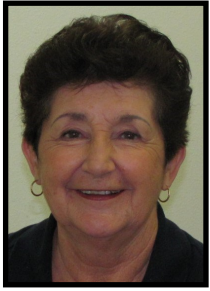

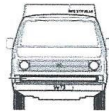
