





They did all the legwork, ordering, picking up, setting up & cleaning up for0 all the members to enjoy! As I mentioned, May will be our last monthly meeting till the Fall, but we will be getting together once at end of May for our breakfast on Thurs. May 30th @ 9 a.m. at Popi's in Bealls Shopping Plaza on Manatee Ave & 65th Street.

Starting in June, we will be restarting our 'Breakfast on the Beach' (yahoo) @ Anna Maria Beach Café located on Manatee Ave & Gulf Dr, on Thurs, June 27th at 9:00a.m...& am hopeful we can get there!!
