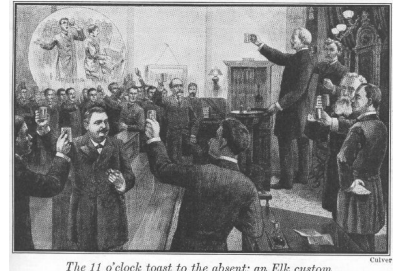

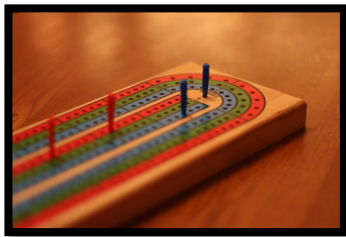

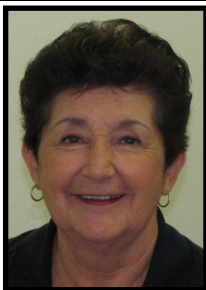

**\*\*February Charity** was for Farm Workers – we collected 40 long-sleeve shirts for Men.

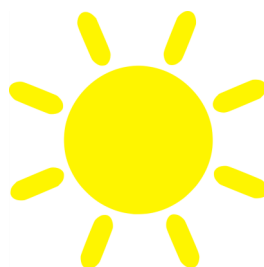
**\*\*March Charity** was for Homeless Women – we collected 17 Large Bags of clothing.

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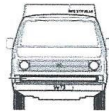
