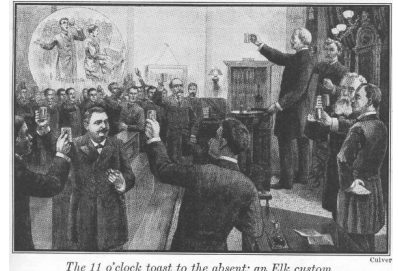

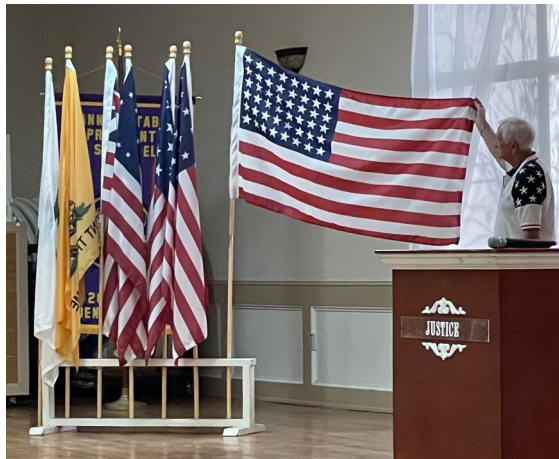


Well, it's been a while but we finally have a winner. She's not just any winner but this is her 3rd time winning the progressive, per Rhoda she should have been in the pool!!

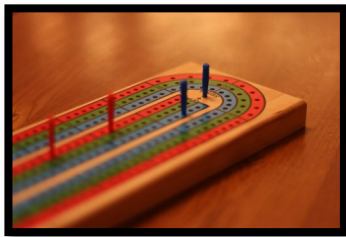

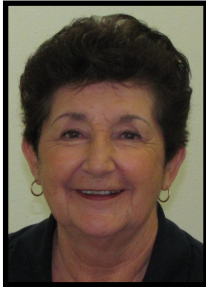

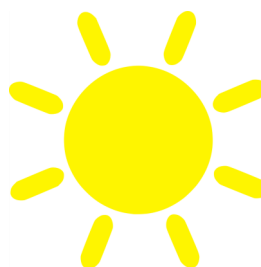
